

NOTICE FOR 2nd ROUND SELECTED CANDIDATES (2021 GKS-G University Track)

Dear Selected Candidates of the 2021 Global Korea Scholarship Graduate Degree Program,

Huge congratulations for making it to the final round of the 2021 GKS-G!

We ask that all selected candidates of the 2nd round whose names are listed in the attached result to carefully read the following and take appropriate actions for final admissions.

1. Medical Examination – Due June 20th (For ALL successful candidates of the 2nd round)

All candidates whose names are listed in the 2nd round result must conduct a medical checkup from a licensed doctor or a physician at a local hospital and submit an **Official Medical Examination AND a laboratory evidence (result of your examination)** officially issued by a hospital or a medical clinic.

- Download the Form “Official Medical Examination” attached to this announcement.
- The Official Medical Examination form must be completed and signed by a licensed physician or a doctor with a MD degree.
- **The laboratory evidence must include all the examinations listed in section “4. Laboratory Examination”.**
- How to submit
 - Email the scanned files of a completed Official Medical Examination report and all laboratory results to gksselection@korea.kr
 - Compile all scanned files into **ONE SINGLE PDF FILE**. Please limit the size of the file less than 5 MB.
 - The name of the file should be **[Your Candidate Number*]-Medical**.

**Candidate Number: Please refer to the "2021 GKS-G University Track 2nd Round Result Successful Candidates" file. In the first column, every candidate is given a Candidate number. When writing your Candidate No., you must write the number in the exact order (if necessary, copy and paste).*

2. Korean Language Program – Due June 20th

All 2021 GKS-G scholars who pass the final round will take one-year mandatory Korean language training at a Korean language institution. The language institution will be announced with the final result and will be indicated on the invitation letter that you will receive from NIIED. Please note that it is NOT POSSIBLE to change the language institution. Each scholar is assigned to a language institution based on one's country of origin and Korean language proficiency so that the diversity is represented in each institution.

Exception: GKS scholars who have valid TOPIK level 5 or 6 will be exempt from the language training program and start their degree program in September 2021.

If you have attained TOPIK level 5 or 6 after you have submitted your applications in March or if you have already received TOPIK level 5 or 6 but did not report your scores to us, please inform us by submitting the **scanned copy of your official TOPIK certificate** to NIIED.

** The 75th TOPIK score is the last TOPIK score one should report to NIIED for exemption from the Korean language program. Applicants who achieved TOPIK level 5 or 6 after application deadline must submit the valid TOPIK certificate to NIIED by Sunday, June 20th, 2021.*

If you have already submitted your TOPIK certificate at the time of application and if there is no change to your TOPIK level, you do not have to re-send the score report.

○ How to submit

- Save a scanned file of your TOPIK certificate into a **PDF** file and name it into a following format: **[Your Candidate Number]-TOPIK**. Please limit the size of the file less than 5 MB.

Attention!!! Attach all files (Medical and TOPIK* if any) to a single email. The subject line of your email must be **[Your Candidate Number]-[Country]-[Last Name]** and please do not include any other text. For example, a candidate named Suzy Park from China should attach her [2021G-UNI-629]-Medical file and [2021G-UNI-629]-TOPIK file in a **single email** with the subject line, **[2021G-UNI-629]-[China]-[Park]**.

Attention!!! Due to security reasons, we cannot open files that are sent via google drive, dropbox, one drive, or any internet-linked files. We only accept files that are sent as an attachment in an email.

- Where to submit: gksselection@korea.kr (This is a receive-only email account for document submission. You will not receive any response to your inquiries regarding the program or application. Should you have inquiries that require response, please send an email to kgspniied@korea.kr)
- Submission Deadline: **Sunday, June 20th, 2021**

Note: We will announce the final results in late-June. However, if a scholar is found to be disqualified or an application document submitted by the scholar is discovered to be a fraudulent, we may cancel his or her scholarship at any time, even after a candidate was announced as a final successful scholar.
